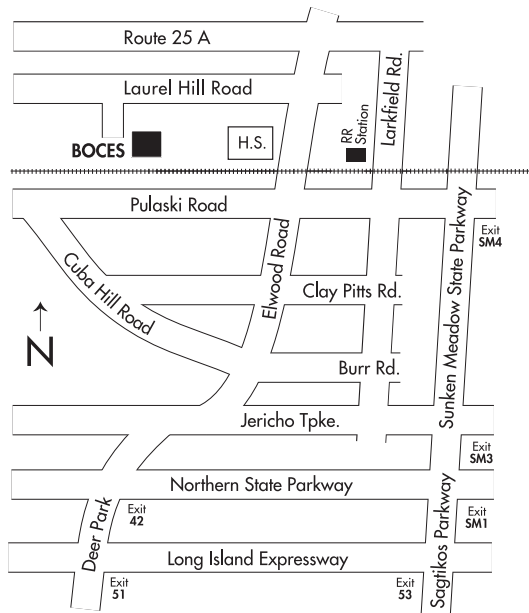

BOCES offers both full and part-time programs to help you prepare for the NYS exam that leads to licensing and a career with many opportunities to work for yourself or for a salon in your community. You can bring additional skills to your career by earning

a license in esthetics from BOCES.

## Cosmetology

For those with artistic flair, cosmetology offers a wide variety of opportunities. Learn care of the skin, hair, scalp, and nails in this 1,000-hour program as you prepare for NYS licensing. Students enjoy practicing on mannequins and fellow classmates as they study hairstyling, coloring, perms and relaxers, make-up application and manicures. Many graduates combine their beauty skills with their business training to open their own businesses. The field offers much flexibility for those who need to work variant schedules.

## Admission Requirements

Students interested in enrolling in the Cosmetology program must meet with a Career Counselor prior to registration. To be admitted, a student must meet one of the following criteria:

- proof of a U.S. high school diploma or GED
- if from a war torn country, a self-certifying letter
- an authorized evaluation of credentials if credentials are from another country
- an acceptable score on an Ability to Benefit Test approved by the U.S. Department of Education

After individual counseling and review of the student's ability to succeed, a counselor may recommend a period of remediation before entry into the program. Call 631-261-3863 for a pre-admission interview.

## Financial Information

Students are required to purchase a cosmetology kit designated uniform and pay a state exam fee not included in tuition (approximately \$230). Information will be provided at registration by the counselor. Payment plans available. Credit cards accepted. Financial aid is available to those eligible. Call 631-667-6000 x455 for information.

## Program Hours

BOCES offers both day-time and evening schedules. Begin monthly with the approval of the counselor and instructor.
