Can you articulate your strengths during the interview process?

Do you know what areas you need to develop further?

What are the leadership skills you need to be an effective administrator?

What should you focus on in your personal staff development activities?

If you are interested in pursuing any or all of the above questions, the 21<sup>st</sup> Century principal Assessment Program may help you answer them!

The Assessment Program is a tool for generating additional information about school personnel who are interested in careers in leadership. A staff of experienced educational leaders, who have been trained and certified by the National Association of Secondary School Principals, will function as assessors and will observe participants as they work through administrative simulations. Participants will be observed as they demonstrate skills that have been identified as critical for success in administration.

The assessor team will produce an extensive report describing strengths and improvement needs for each participant. The Center Director will review this report with each individual in a private feedback session.

The fee for this program is \$985—which is BOCES aidable if your district sponsors you.
