### RECOVERY COACH

Offered by Western Suffolk BOCES in coordination with Healthspan.US.

Prepare to work in the addiction and mental health field as a Recovery Coach to help people along the path of recovery. Recovery Coaches do not provide clinical help or dispense medication; instead they work with the recoveree, either as a solo coach or part of a team. This class fulfills the 60-hour educational requirements set forth by NYS and the Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS) to become a NY-certified Recovery Addictions Recovery Coach or NY-certified Addiction Recovery Advocate.

Curriculum includes the role of recovery coaches, core values and guiding principles of recovery, the stages of recovery, wellness planning, ethics, as well as spirituality and what this means to each individual as it pertains to recovery. Class has four modules:

- Module I-Recovery Coach Academy (30hrs)
- Module II-NYS Ethics (12hrs)
- Module III-Medically Assisted Treatment (6hrs)
- Module IV-Spirituality (12hrs)

Upon successful completion of each module you will receive a Healthspan.US certificate as well as information to receive your CCAR Certificate (Connecticut Community for Addiction Recovery) which you will need to file your NYS application. No prerequisites.

Additional fees: \$139 for manuals and materials due on first night of class, payable by money order only to HealthSpan.US; \$100 Application fee for certification exam; \$125 for NYS Recovery Coach Certification Exam (paid to NYS when application is submitted). There will be a \$13/hr make-up fee for any approved hours missed.
