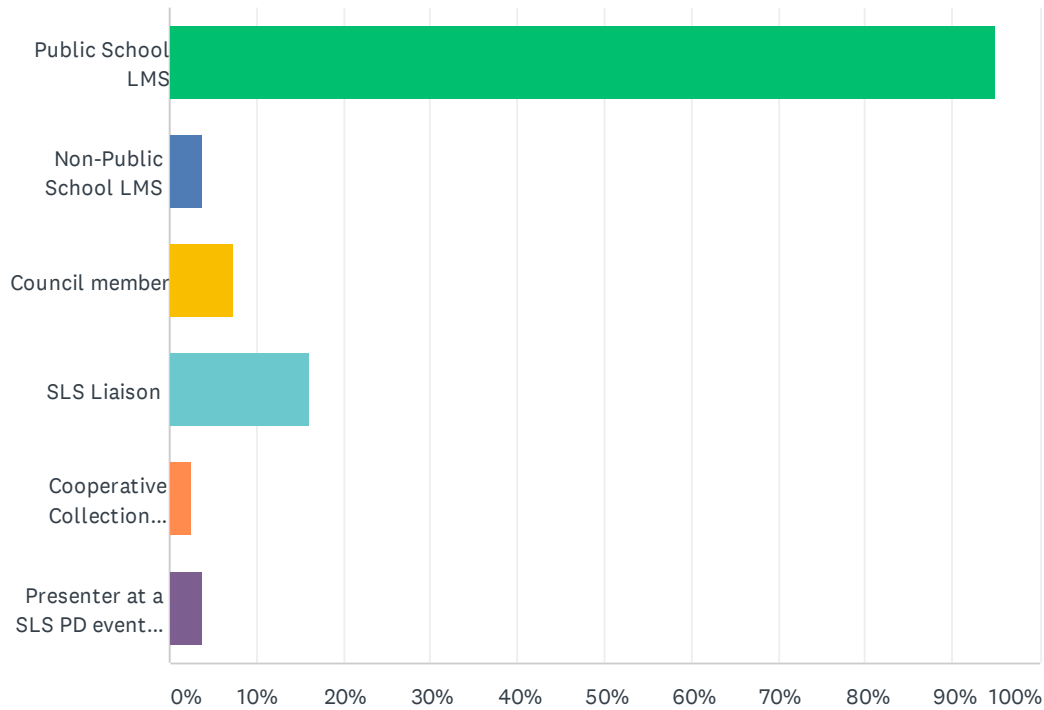

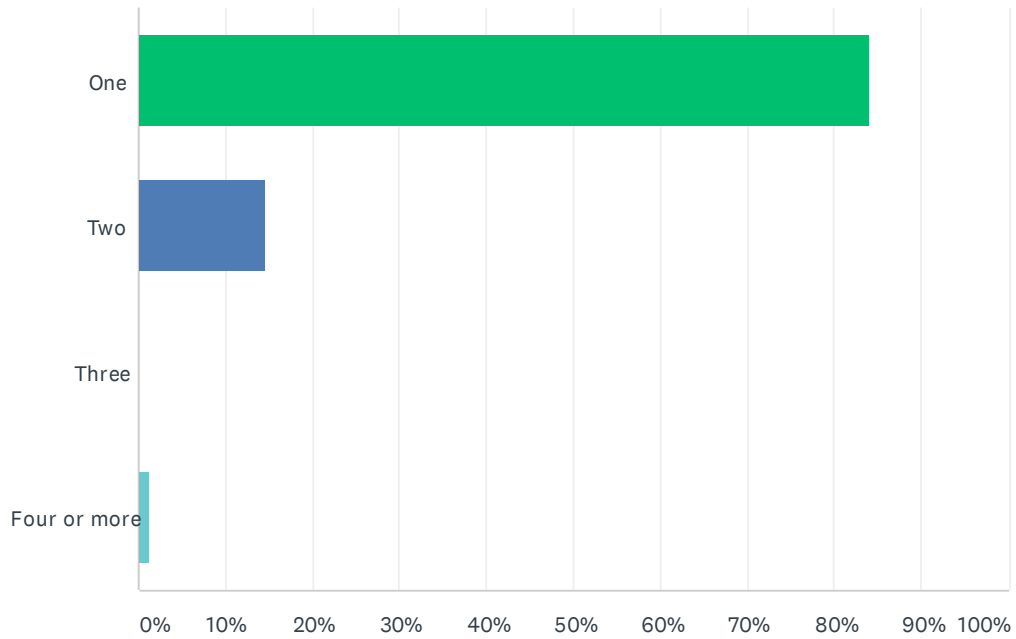

Q2 How many different buildings do you currently work in?

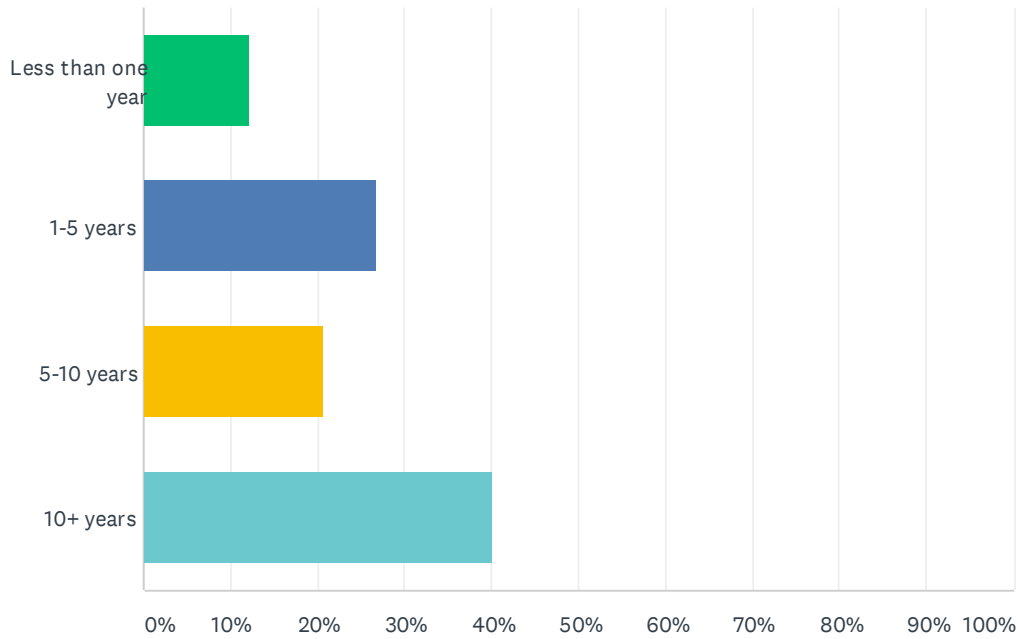

Q3 How long have you been working in your current building(s)?

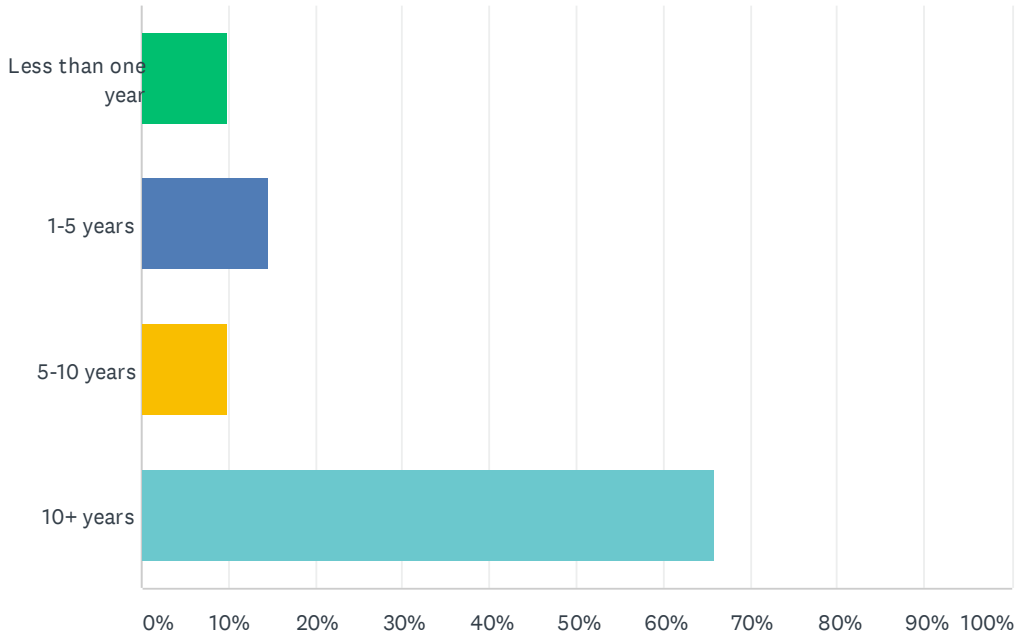

Q4 How long have you worked in your current district?

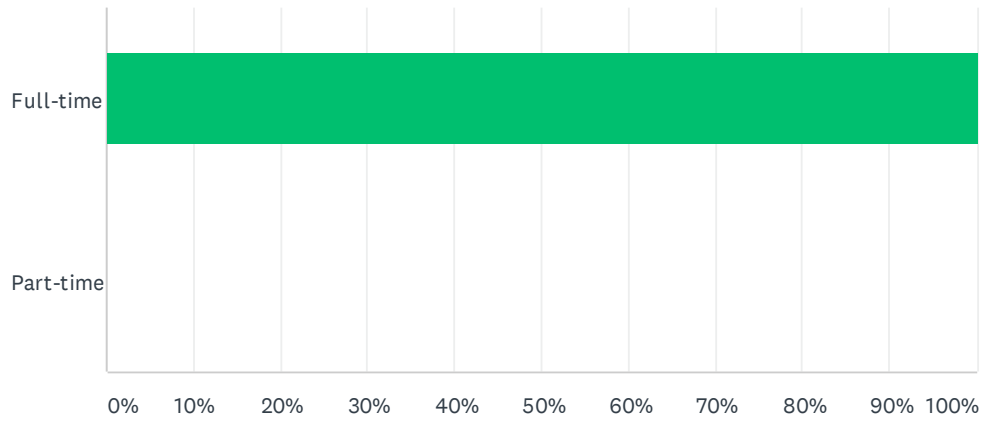

Q5 Are you working in a full-time or part-time position?

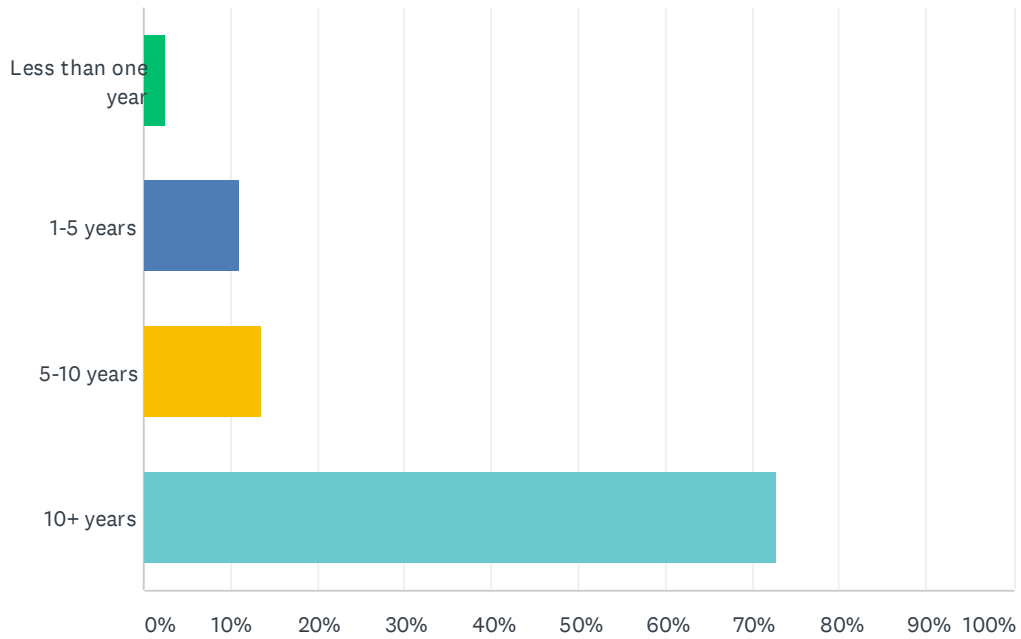

Q6 How long have you worked as an SLMS?

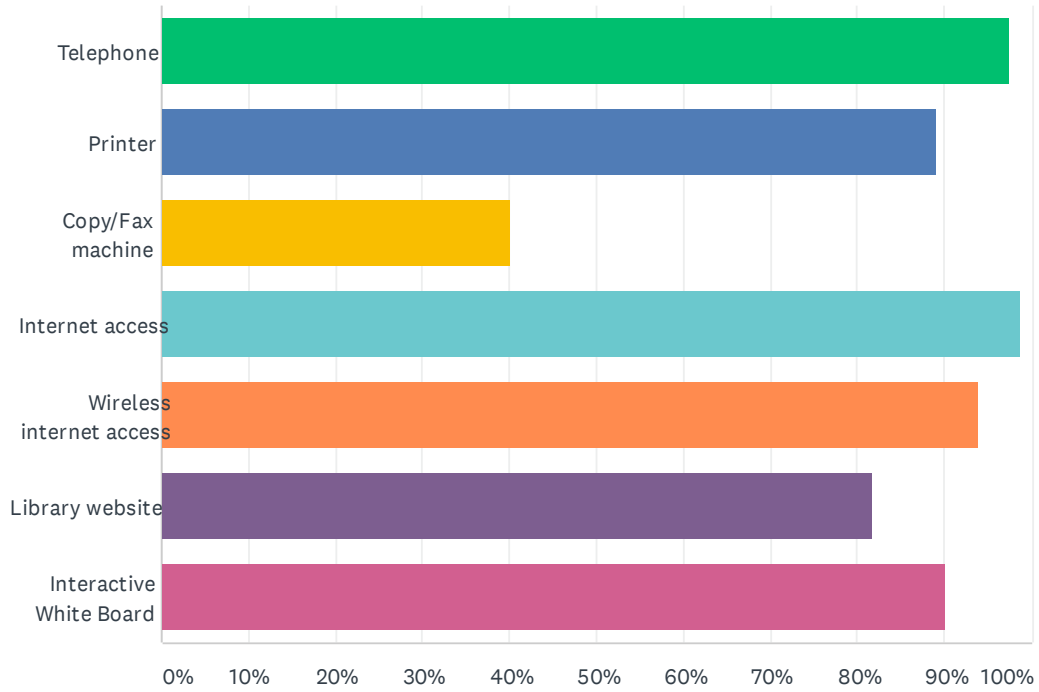

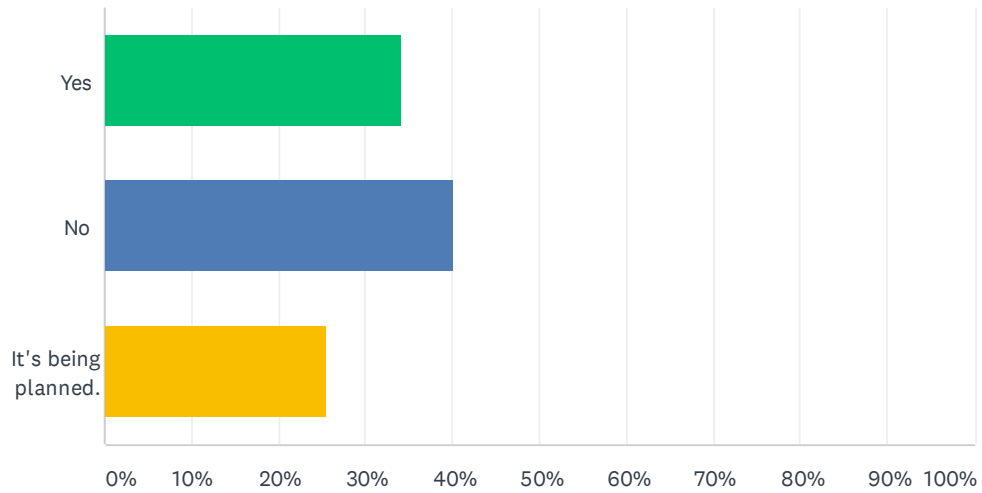

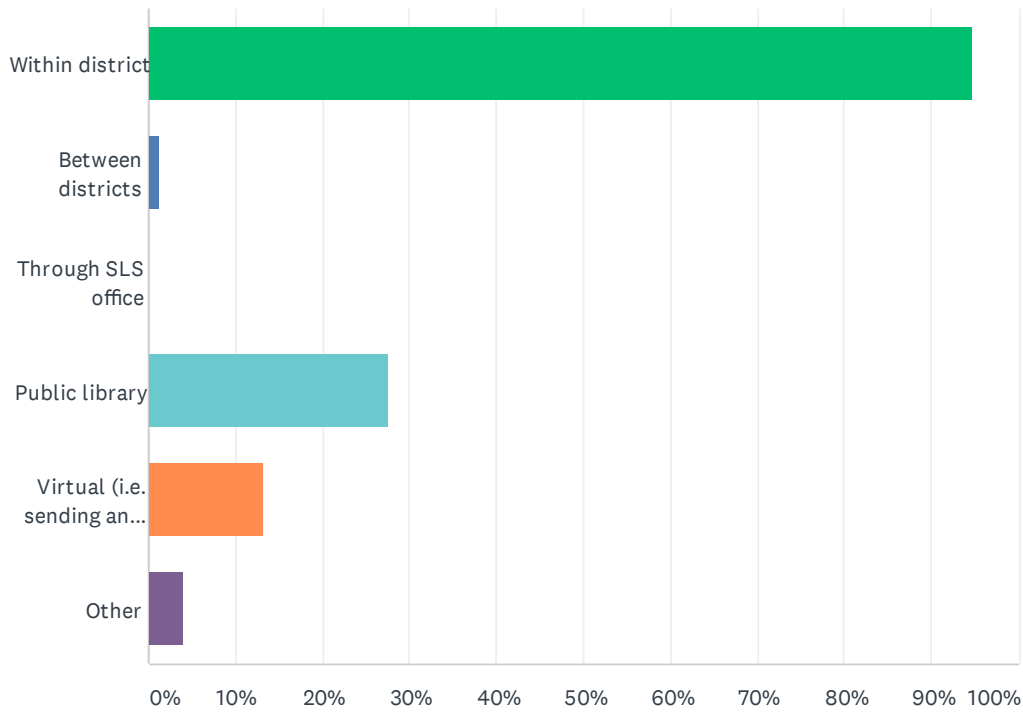

Q13 Please check all that apply. What form of interlibrary loan have you used?

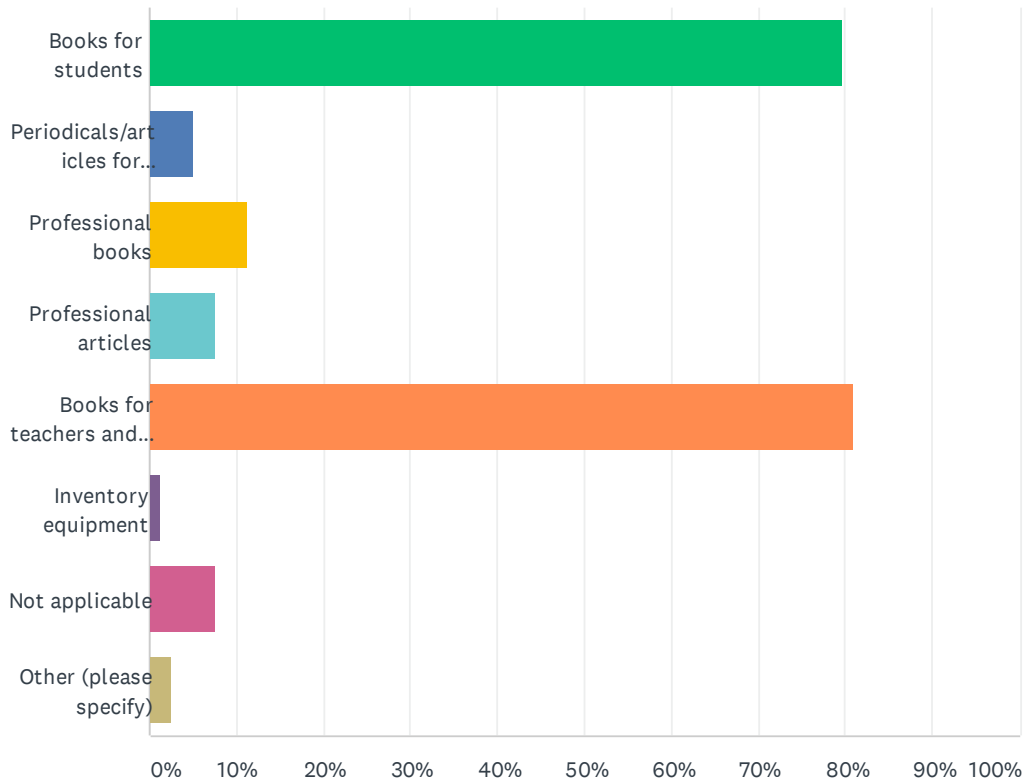

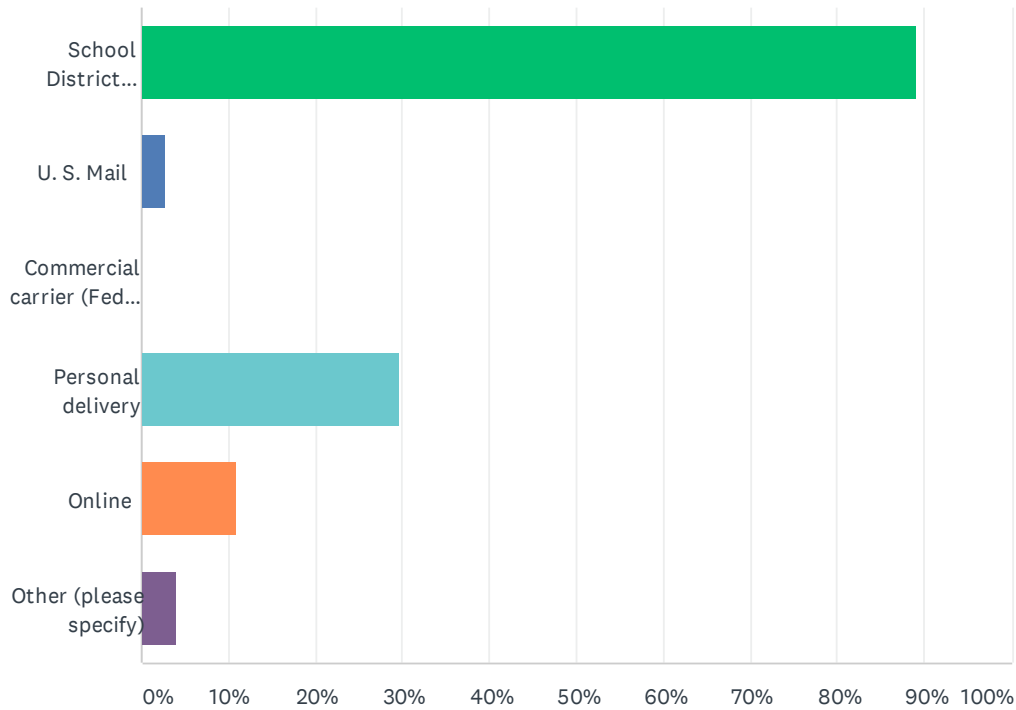

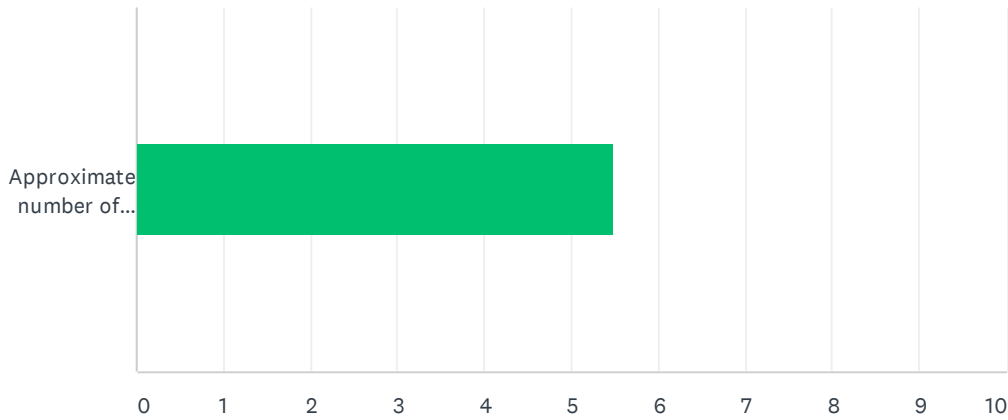

Q17 How much has ILL helped improve your ability to provide resources?

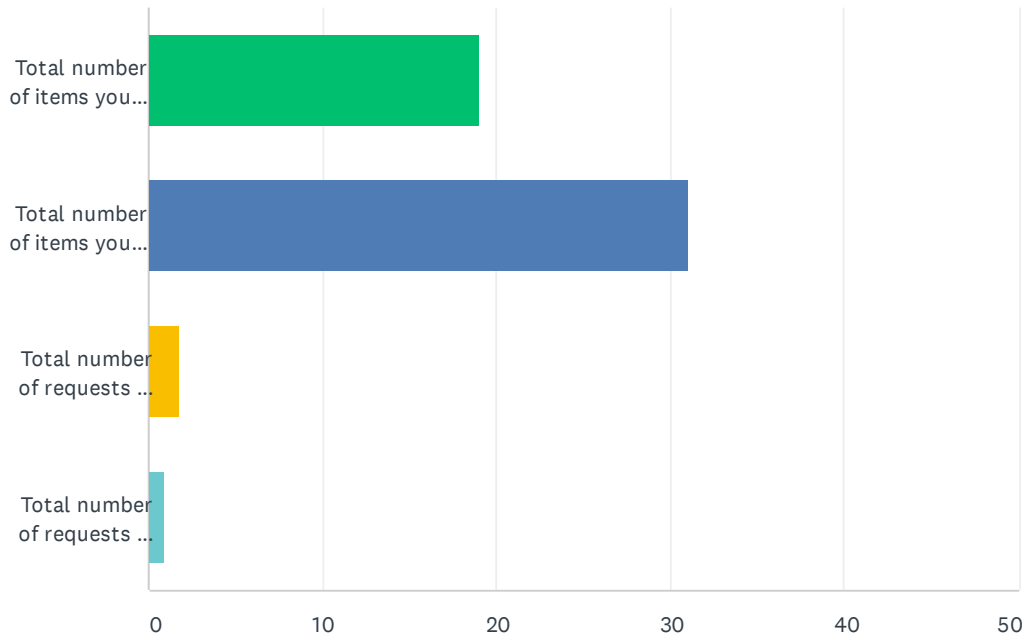

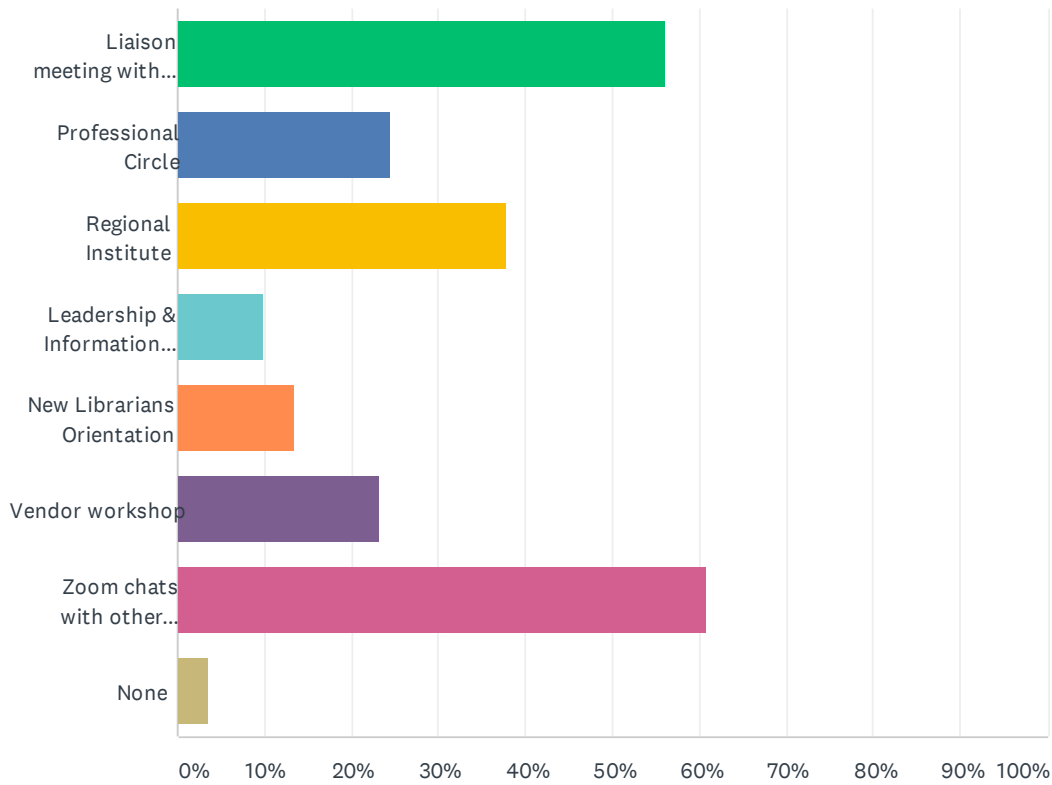

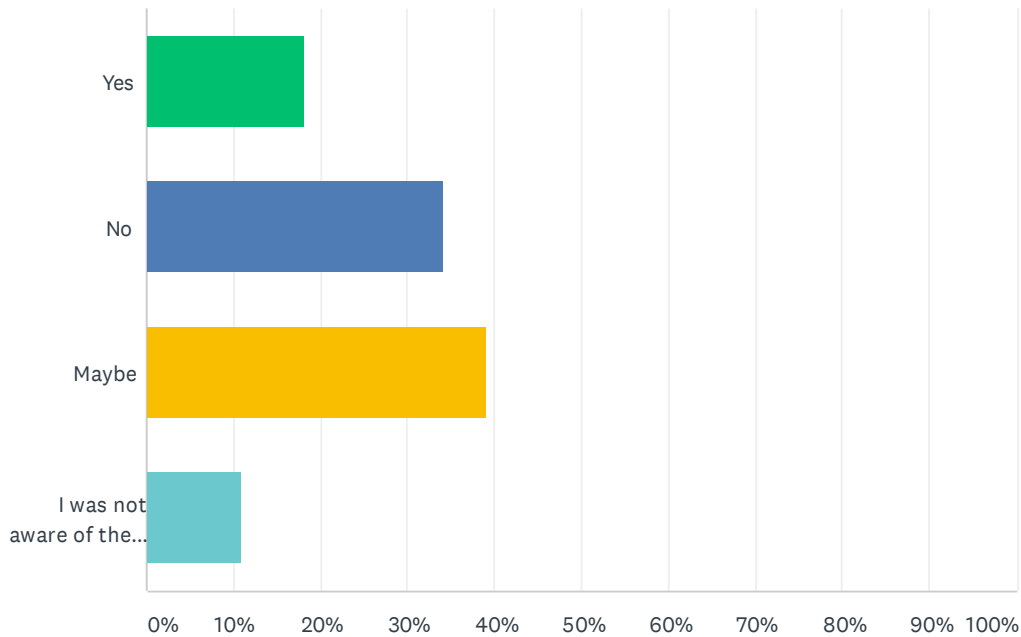

Q43 Please rate the ease of use of the "Online Resources Spreadsheet and Pricelist" for ordering products through SLS.

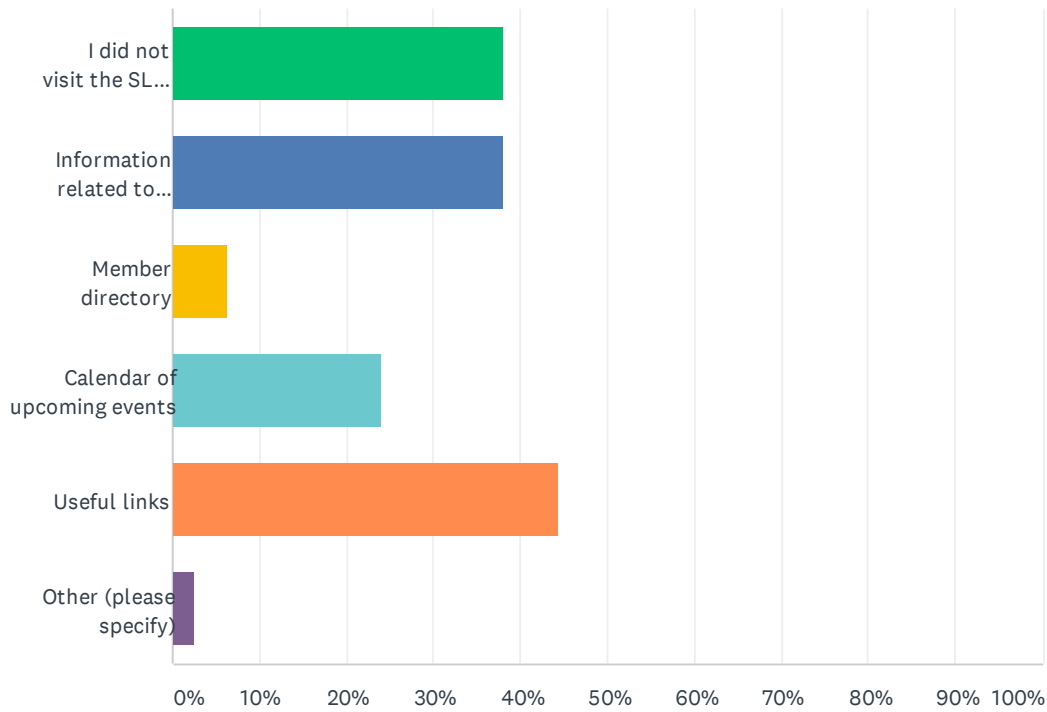

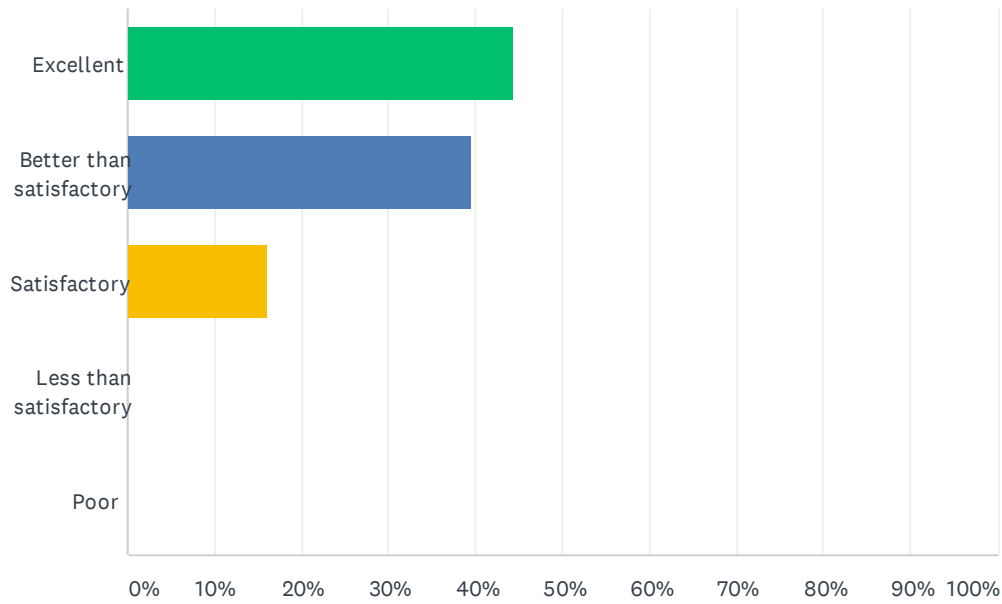

Q45 How would you rate the overall impact of the SLS on your library programs?

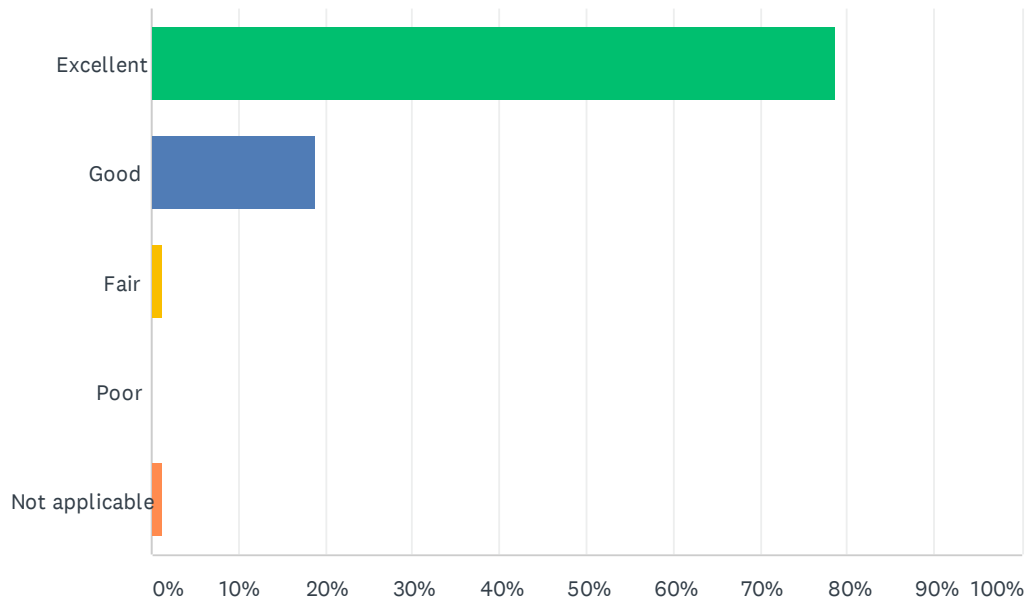
