

# Contact Tracing of Positive COVID-19 Cases

If a student presents with symptoms during the school day, the student will be directed to the supervised isolation area to await parent pick-up. Staff who are symptomatic will be sent home immediately. Parents and staff members will be directed to consult with healthcare providers regarding assessment and testing.

**NEGATIVE CASE:** The individual may return to school after providing a note from medical provider, a negative result from a COVID-19 test, or the individual has been symptom-free for 24 hours.

**POSITIVE CASE:** If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, the principal will notify Suffolk County Department of Health and Central Administration.

## Contact Tracing

SCDOH is responsible for contact tracing and WSBOCES will support SCDOH by confirming attendance and sharing logs of close contacts (i.e., students or staff who have been within 6 ft or less for more than 10 minutes of the individual with the positive case). SCDOH will direct close contacts to self-quarantine for 14 days.

## Isolation of Individual with Positive Case

SCDOH will direct individuals with confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 to isolate for 10 days. At the conclusion of the isolation period, SCDOH will provide individual with a clearance letter to provide to school.
